Tony Shearer didn't like the look of the new owners of Singer&Friedlander, so he took off. He even tried to warn the FSA that it would not be wise to sell them the bank. He resigned from his job but worked with Sigurður Einarsson, Hreiðar Má Sigurðsson and Ármann Þorvaldsson for a few months. Spending those few month with them didn't exactly make him think any higher of them.

We did a very interesting and extensive interview with Tony Shearer. Parts of that interview have already been aired on Silfur Egils and can be seen in Trailers. To give an example, Tony talks about a meeting he had with the Icelandic FSA. You do not want to miss that.
